
DAVIS AQUATIC MASTERS – ASSISTANT SWIM COACH

Minimum Requirements

- USMS member.
- Current certification in Lifeguard Training, First Aid, CPR and AED standards, and the Red Cross Title 22 class which covers First Aid for the Professional. DAM's budget provides funds for recertifications.
- Communication skills, verbal and written.
- ASCA Masters Certified Level 1 or 2, or one year masters coaching experience.

Desirable Requirements

- Knowledge of swim stroke mechanics and the ability to demonstrate, explain, and correct swimming technique.
- Former competitive swimmer

Job Duties Under the direction of the head coach, the assistant coach shall:

- Be scheduled to average 20 hours per week in actual coaching time.
- Coach additional workouts when the head coach is unavailable.
- Provide coaching services, including stroke instruction, and positive motivation for swimmers to achieve their individual swimming goals.

Salary and Application Requirements

DAM offers a competitive salary package commensurate with experience. The package includes a base salary of \$25,000-\$35,000, plus vacation, retirement, health insurance, professional development, and travel expense reimbursement for swim meets.

The preferred start date is September 1, 2023. The position will remain open until filled. The DAM Board of Directors reserves the right to conduct in-depth pre-employment screening, including but not limited to criminal background check, physical, drug screening, past employment and education verification, and a social media review.
